- Design engaging and innovative visual content for social media platforms, including Instagram, Facebook, and LinkedIn.
- Craft dynamic animations and motion graphics that align with ECL's branding.
- Stay up to date with design trends, promote new ideas and techniques to engage with ECL's internal and external audiences.
- Travel to service locations across Essex as and when required.
